 - Respect -- Treat all members with fairness and dignity. Treating others the way you would want to be treated.
 - Volunteer Service -- Going out of your way to help and meet the needs of your fellow CAP members..
- I will become part of the team, cooperating with and supporting one another, whether it's your flight, a study group, your squadron or the entire encampment.
- I will participate actively in all training, recreational, and social activities during the encampment.
- I will not abuse, bully, discriminate, or haze another member regardless of their actions or beliefs and I will discourage other members from doing so and immediately report any incidents to the Encampment Commander.
- I will wear the CAP uniform properly and observe all military customs and courtesies.
